

*This legislative session, Planned Parenthood fought diligently for the reproductive rights of all Arizonans. There was commonsense legislation offered that addressed fundamental health care needs, only to have it rejected by anti-choice legislators in favor of extreme legislation preventing women and families from accessing care.*

**Legislation we supported:**

- ✓ **HB 2428**- This bill would have required hospitals to provide Emergency Contraception (EC) to sexual assault survivors in the emergency room; recognized the duty of pharmacies and providers to stock and dispense EC, and provided for an awareness program to educate Arizonans about EC. **No action was taken on this bill.**  
**Sponsors: Representatives Tovar (LD13) and Miranda (LD13).**
- ✓ **SB 1457** – This bill would have required all schools to provide sex education that is "medically accurate" and "comprehensive." **No action was taken on this bill.** **Sponsors: Senators Sinema (LD15), Reagan (LD8), Cajero Bedford (LD27), Gallardo (LD13), Meza (LD14) and Jackson (LD2).**

**Legislation we opposed:**

- ◆ **HB 2416** - Redefines taking the abortion pill as "surgery." This extravagant over-regulation will result in more than half of Arizona's current abortion providers becoming ineligible to provide care. Rural women will lose access to abortion entirely, as abortion-by-pill is the only form of care outside Phoenix and Tucson. This proposal aims to reduce abortion early in pregnancy, since abortion-by-pill is used by women in the fifth to ninth week of pregnancy. **This bill was signed into law on 4/2/11.**
- ◆ **HB 2384** - This bill excludes Planned Parenthood from eligibility as a qualifying organization for The Working Poor Tax Credit. It **excludes organizations that serve the working poor from qualifying** under the "working poor donation tax credit" program for charitable organizations if they provide or refer for abortion care and prohibits public money from being spent on abortion care training which is already prohibited in Arizona. **This bill was signed into law on 4/12/11.**
- ◆ **HB 2443** – By banning race and gender selection abortion, this bill tries to create the impression that women and families are deciding to end pregnancies on those bases. Since there absolutely no evidence that this is occurring, this bill is solely designed to further damage the reputations of women who choose abortion. **This bill was signed into law on 3/29/11.**
- ◆ **HB 1169 (Strike-Everything Amendment)** – Prohibits the Arizona Board of Nursing from determining whether abortion care is within the scope of practice of a highly trained nurse practitioner. **This bill was signed into law 4/18/11.**
- ◆ **SB 1030 (Strike-Everything Amendment)** - Prohibits physician's assistants from providing abortion-by-pill. **This bill was signed into law 4/19/11.**
